CLERKS REPORT

The suggested names for the name bank have been submitted to ERYC
The village hall have been forwarded the CCTV policy to read and if in agreement to agree.
The bin in the playground and on High Street have been replaced.
The tarmac at the junction of Cliff Lane/High Street was reported to ERYC as crumbling.
I contacted the street light department to ask when the lights were last cleaned, this is scheduled for February.
The overgrown hedge at the back of the school onto Scarsea Way was reported to ERYC but I have since been informed that it is the school which oversees this work. I have informed the headmistress.
I have sent a reminder email to ERYC regarding the flashing speed sign in Buckton.
We have changed the contract for the church clock, but at present the clock is not chiming.
I have spoken with Vincent regarding the trimming of the trees at the Buckton pond, to remove the dead tree opposite, cut the trees at the side of the playground.
I have emailed Esk Valley coaches regarding using Bolam Lane, they were informed that Bolam Lane is not an official bus route and not gritted in severe weather conditions. They were also told that the coaches are churning the verges causing mud on the road.
Potholes on Jewison Lane and Flamborough Road were reported to ERYC.
A letter has been sent to the property owner of the overgrown hedge which is blocking the splay vision when existing Bolam Lane onto Bempton Lane.
I have contacted ERYC to ask whether the footpath on the corner of School Lane is to be resurfaced, this matter will be reviewed in the New Year.
A over grown tree on Gillus Lane was reported to Highways as it was interfering with the overhead cables, ERYC have since removed the tree.
