Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2016 at 7.30pm Bempton Primary School, School Lane, Bempton.

Applicant: Mr Roy Artley. Application type: Outlined Planning permission.

The Parish Council object to the planning application on the grounds that the entrance nearest the cottage does not have a clear safe exit from the proposed development. This entrance is too close to the adjacent cottage which is sited along the highway and upon a blind bend.

The Parish Council recommend that this entrance is relocated three quarters of the way along the frontage of the proposed site.
